


Transition of Visitors (Unit: Person)

From the era of construction, we are now moving on to the next stage. Towards the "future" of Minato Mirai, we will create and imbue excitement and value by combining the strengths of people in a variety of professions. Here are four initiatives we are currently undertaking.

Theme 1 Open Innovation

An Initiative to support the creation of new technologies through exchange between local companies by taking advantage of the concentration of R&D centers, start-up companies and universities.

We will hold the "YOXO FESTIVAL", where you can experience innovation, and have opportunities to feel the excitement of the future with new technologies while touring the city.



Theme² Music Port YOKOHAMA

An initiative to create a city overflowing with music through music and other facilities.

Information on performances and interviews with people involved in the music industry are posted on the website, and musicians of various genres perform throughout the city. In addition, "OTO-GIFT", a service that offers discounts on food and beverages by presenting live concert tickets, has been launched.



Theme³ Minato Mirai Art & Museum

An initiative to provide opportunities to make new discoveries and gain new insights in cooperation with corporate museums and art museums.

Maps that are useful for summer science projects by schoolchildren are distributed, and a project has been organized in which they can complete an illustrated book while touring the facilities.


